**Ask permission to speak or to leave your seat.**



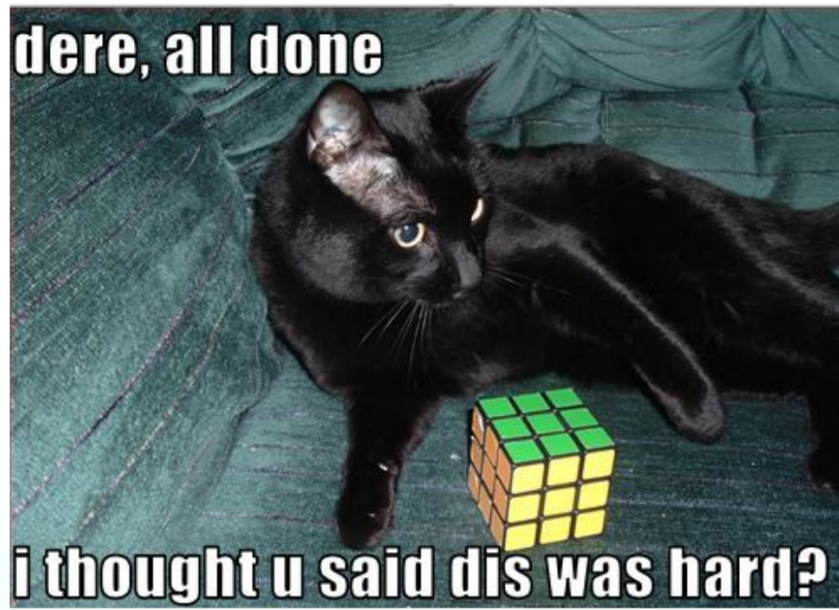
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**If you finish early, make sure you have a book to read.**
